

Central Oregon SxS Where To Ride Maps

Map #1

Parking: 1) Edison Sno-Park. 2) Wanoga Sno-Park. (Lots of room in both)
3) Crane Prairie Reservoir Camping by lake (Smaller Vehicles Only, PU camper and small trailer)

Features: Kwohle Snow Shelter. Sheridan Snow Shelter. Pistol Butte, Wake Butte, Lookout Mountain.

Map #2 Connects to Map #5

Parking: 1) Power Line on China Hat Road. Large area.

Features Map #1 Fuzztail Butte (Great views), Small Crack in the Ground, Explore the lava flow. Miles of fun close to Bend.

2) Forest Road 9724. (ODOT cinder storage area. summer parking only). Large area

3) Features: Sugar Pine Butte, Drive across the lava flow, Ponderosa Pine. Ride onto Map #5 and visit McKay Butte and Suvaylor's Lava Flow for a long day of riding.

Map #3 You will want Map #6 & #7

Parking: 1) East Fort Rock OHV Trail System Road 2510 Staging Area.

Use Forest Road 2510 to travel south to road 650 and road 500 to access routes on Map #6.

Features (Map #6) Quartz Mountain, Derrick Cave, Burnt Butte, Plot Butte, Antelope Butte. Add Map #7 for a trip to the town of Hampton (Gas available), for a great hamburger.

Map #4

Parking: 1) Burgess Road near Pringle Butte.

Wickiup Reservoir. Disperse camping along North Davis Creek, SW area. (Smaller Vehicles Only, PU camper and small trailer). OHVs are not permitted in the North Davis Creek CG.

Features: Pringle Butte, Davis Mountain, Charlton Lake, Manley's Tavern (Roasted Chicken).

Map #5 Add Map #6 & Map #9

Parking: 1) 6 Mile Sno-Park 2) South Lava Staging Area, Large Rigs. 3) South Ice Cave, Smaller Rigs. 4) Dispersed site on road 22 just east of road 18. Large Rigs

Features: Indian Butte, Refer to Map #6 Derrick Cave, Quartz Mountain, Oregon's Largest Juniper Tree.

Map #9 Hole in the Ground, Fort Rock State Park, Town of Fort Rock and Watering Hole Tavern (Great Hamburger).

Map #6 Additional Map #3

Parking: 1) Dispersed camp on Forest Road 400 off of Forest Road 2312. Near Sand Springs. Large Rigs. Great camp for SxS trip to Hampton (Map #7).

Features: Indian Butte, Derrick Cave, Quartz Mountain, Oregon's Largest Juniper Tree, Plot Butte, Antelope Butte.

Add Map #7 Take a trip to the town of Hampton, (Gas Available).

Add Maps #9 & #10 Devil's Garden Lava field, Cabin Lake, BS Well and Old Homestead.

Map #7 Additional Map #6

Parking: 1) Hampton Store / Café. (Great Burgers). Great area to park if you want to explore the surrounding BLM areas, Oregon Outback. Respect Private Property.

Features: Indian Butte, Map #6 Derrick Cave, Quartz Mountain, Oregon's Largest Juniper Tree, Plot Butte, Antelope Butte.

Map #8 Also refer to Map #1, #4 & (#5 Route from Hwy 97 to parking at Pringle Butte).

Features: Pumice Pit, Odell Butte, Manley's.

The town of Crescent and the Crescent Ranger District are working on adding more access to areas in the region. Watch for the streets of Crescent to open to OHVs. Additional parking near community of Crescent Lake on Hwy 58.
